

I believe in God, the Father almighty, creator of heaven and earth.

If medical or health concerns give you reason to avoid the wine or bread, please remember the teaching of the Christian Church that Christ is fully present in either element alone, bread or wine.



Communion preparation is offered each year for 5th grade and younger. Children who do not yet commune are invited for a blessing.
