## WHERE DO WE BELONG?

Over a year ago, someone asked me the question, "What is one new thing you've been doing that you wouldn't have done if COVID-19 never existed?" The answer for me was that I have been re-connecting with some wonderful college friends of mine that I had lost touch with. At the beginning of the pandemic, when we were all locked down with nowhere to go, one of my friends reached out and asked if our group would like to get together for a Zoom gathering on a Friday night. We would talk and maybe play some games and have a beer as we chatted together over the internet.

When we had this gathering, it made me realize how much I had missed my friends. Getting together with them, even in this virtual way, made me feel a sense of belonging I hadn't felt in a while. It was like I was "at home" with some of my favorite people again. And though not everyone can always make it, almost two years after that initial Zoom meeting, this same group has an opportunity to check in with each other every Friday night.

This is a group where I know I belong. And I wonder if this experience with my friends isn't a perfect example of the ways that God is always there offering moments of love, connection, and belonging every day.

In this last couple of years, many of us have lost a lot. We have been separated from one another in more ways than one. We have experienced disagreements with family members and friends. We have been overburdened with everyday decisions, and anxiety about what's next, and I think many of us are tired. Many of us are longing for connection, and a sense of belonging, and a space where we can re-connect with each other and with God.

This Lent, we are going to be focusing on that very thing: *where do we belong?* We will explore together the surprising places where God meets us in our everyday lives. We know that we belong to God. We know that we belong to each other. But in the hustle and bustle of the everyday demands and worries, we can forget that God is showing up in our lives in ordinary places and people. So, let's remind each other about the tender connections God is offering us, and the places where God is offering new life even when we don't notice it.

To get you started thinking along with us, a few questions: Where is God already meeting you in the normal spaces of your life? Have you seen God show up at church, or with your friends, or in your family? Or have you experienced God meeting you out in nature, or at your son or daughter's sporting events, or maybe even in your workplace? Join us as we remind each other of the God who is reaching out to us every day in love. Join us as we remind each other that we belong to each other, and that we all belong to God.

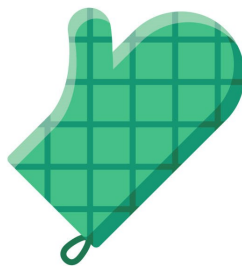

## EXPLORING VINJE'S HISTORY

*This month pastor Andrés wanted to know more about the so called "dome" we used to have over the pulpit. He is grateful to several members of the congregation who shared information and has special thanks to pastor Engholm for the details and photos he provided.*



There used to be a "dome" over the pulpit in our sanctuary. People has described it in different ways. Someone told me that they always thought that it looked like a contact lens. It was hung when the sanctuary was built.

The dome was made of white plastic, and originally it served more than just a decorative purpose. Apparently, it was supposed to enhance the voice of the preacher. It could also be lit. There was a button on the floor of the pulpit that the pastor could step on when they entered and exited the pulpit to turn the light on and off.

When Maxine Anfinson worked in the church office back in the 90's, she sometimes helped the janitor, Marg Leraas clean the dome. They had to use a big ladder and long handled dust mops sprayed with Windex...and they always remembered to say a prayer first as they feared falling or breaking the dome.

The dome stayed in its place until it was taken down in December of 2012 during pastor Jeff Engholm's tenure as pastor at Vinje. He recalls that the chains that held it up were disintegrating, and that it also blocked the view of the newly installed screens. Therefore, the decision was made to take it down. Vinje members helped take it down and put it in storage in the quilting room.

I suspect that there was another reason for taking the dome down. I have been told that some teens would sit in the balcony during worship and attempt to throw paper airplanes into the dome during the sermon. I have heard that choir members would do the same if the sermon was too boring. In fact, I have also been told that pastor Glenn Taibl used to go over to the sanctuary with his daughter outside worship time to throw paper airplanes from the balcony towards the dome, and the paper airplanes would really fly some neat ways when the air or the heat were on.
