

#### **EXPLORING VINJE'S HISTORY**

This month pastor Andrés asked Pastor Amy Juel to share her memories from her ordination that took place at Vinje in 2012.

One Sunday morning in 2006, I talked with Dr. Rick Bliese, President of Luther Seminary during fellowship about the call to ministry that I was feeling and the wheels started turning!

I was gifted with a Dorothy Olson Seminary Scholarship that funded my tuition, books, travel, and supplemental needs. Sherri (former Financial Secretary) was an angel when it came to taking care of the paperwork and bills. Pastors Steve, Barbara and Mary were integral parts of my education, mentoring, and support. Vinje members such as Jean & Todd Geselius, Kim Davis, and others helped care for my four young children by providing meals, rides, and childcare. Many more were supportive through prayer and encouragement-and still are! Vinje will always hold a special place in my heart.

I was ordained to the Ministry of Word and Sacrament on May 29, 2012 at Vinje. It was a beautiful service full of music, prayer, tradition, and celebration..

Surrounded by my family, friends, and colleagues, I was presented for ordination by the Area Churches Together (ACT) Parish to which I had been called. Bishop Jon Anderson led the Rite of Ordination. After answering these questions, Bishop Jon and I walked to the center of Vinje's round sanctuary and the clergy and congregation encircled us and laid hands on me. Bishop Jon then prayed for me, my ministry, and my service in the world.

At the altar, my first stole was presented and placed around my shoulders by my husband. This stole is a reminder that Jesus called me to "take my yoke upon you" Matthew 11:28-30.

Bishop Jon spoke to me, "Care for God's people, bear their burdens, and do it betray their confidence. So discipline yourself in life and teaching that you preserve the truth, giving no occasion for false security or illusory hope. Witness faithfully in word and deed to all people. Give and receive comfort as you serve within the church."



At that point, I was invited to lead the rest of the service, including presiding over Holy Communion. It was a beautiful gift and blessing to speak the words, "Given for you" to all of the people who had loved, supported, and prayed for me on my faith journey. What an amazing way to begin a vocation!

#### **UPDATE FROM YOUR CREATION CARE COMMITTEE**

A few members of the Vinje Creation Care Team answered the invitation to attend 5 Zoom classes on creation care, presented by the Ecofaith Network of the NE MN synod. The presenters were members of a creation care team from around the state, and shared some of the things they have done and inspired us to consider some of their ideas. In the coming months, our team will be considering and implementing some these ideas. One inspiring idea was a middle-schooler thought his congregation should eliminate the use of paper napkins, so he volunteered to launder cloth napkins until he graduated from high school, then someone else took on the task! Some congregations have gone solar, while others are considering it. Many are trying to lower or eliminate their carbon footprint.
